We are writing to invite you to our Lodge's Third Annual FOP sponsored Firearms Day on Saturday, September 19, 2009. Only current members in good standing or new members are invited. Anyone who is not a current member but wishes to shoot can fill out an application, pay next year's dues, and join the Lodge. We will again be holding the event at no cost to our members/prospective members. This year the Shoot will be at the Freeport New York Revolver and Rifle Range, 125 Buffalo Avenue, Freeport NY 11520. You can obtain directions from their website at [www.freeportrevolver.com](http://www.freeportrevolver.com). The use of the range is free but you must bring your own weapon, ammunition, eye and ear protection.

There will be an open shoot from 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM. At 9:30 AM we will run a timed fifty shot course of fire for anyone willing to participate, followed by tactical shooting scenarios till 12:45 PM. We must have the range vacant and clean prior to 1:00 PM.

This is an advanced course and all participants must have passed a basic agency firearms course prior to participating. Our Lodge has developed a Close Quarters Combat (CQC) Course we will run again as this year's course of fire. The course was developed to place the shooter in situations not addressed through basic agency firearms qualifications. There are significant shooting positions on the ground so wear clothing you don't mind getting a little/very dirty. Individuals with revolvers can shoot this course. After running the course we will run several short tactical scenarios for shooters wishing to participate. We will provide targets for our CQC course and will also provide a certificate to our members. If you let us know at least a week ahead of time you will be attending, your certificate will be presented to you the day of the shoot.

Unfortunately there is no picnic area close so we will have a general meeting and pizza and sodas after the Shoot. The Lodge will pay for the pizza and sodas for all who attend the general Lodge meeting.
