Dear Member:

We are writing to invite you to our Lodge's Fourth Annual FOP sponsored Firearms Day on Saturday, September 18, 2009. Only current members in good standing or new members are invited. Anyone who is not a current member but wishes to shoot can fill out an application, pay next year's dues, and join the Lodge. We will again be holding the event at no cost to our members/prospective members. This year the Shoot will be at the Freeport New York Revolver and Rifle Range, 125 Buffalo Avenue, Freeport NY 11520. You can obtain directions from their website at www.freeportrevolver.com. The use of the range is free but you must bring your own weapon, ammunition, targets, eye and ear protection.

There will be an open shoot from 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM. At 9:30 AM we will run a timed fifty shot Close Quarter's Combat course of fire for anyone willing to participate. We will also run a fifty shot Multiple Assailant Course following this for anyone wishing to participate. Any time remaining until 12:45 PM will be for open shooting. We must have the range vacant and clean prior to 1:00 PM.

Both courses of fire are advanced courses and all participants must have passed a basic agency firearms course prior to participating. Every shooter must also sign a liability waiver to be allowed to shoot at our event. Our Lodge has developed a Close Quarters Combat (CQC) Course we will run again as this year's course of fire. The course was developed to place the shooter in situations not addressed through basic agency firearms qualifications. There are significant shooting positions on the ground so wear clothing you don't mind getting a little/very dirty. Our Lodge has also developed a new Multiple Assailant Course we will run for the first time this year. This course is to develop the shooter's target acquisition and firing skills for multiple simultaneous targets. Individuals with revolvers can shoot both courses. We will provide targets for our CQC course and Multiple Assailant course. We will also send certificates to our members for both courses.

After the shoot we will have a general meeting at a local eatery. The Lodge will pay for the pizza and sodas for all who attend the general Lodge meeting. We will also be loading up and bringing all our merchandise for sale, and selling raffle tickets for a 32 inch flat screen TV, so bring lots of money. Lastly, we will have 2010 applications available for new and returning members and we will accept next year's dues at this time.
